Christian Brothers College is proud to partner with Flinders University through Flinders Aligned, a co-designed pathway program that recognises both SACE Stage 2 subjects and Vocational Education and Training (VET) as valuable preparation for university.

Designed to provide clear and transparent pathways into selected Flinders degrees, Flinders Aligned empowers students to make informed subject choices and prepare confidently for future study and career opportunities.

CBC currently offers three aligned pathways:

- Sport Pathway (Diploma)
- Sport Pathway (Bachelor)
- Business Pathway (Bachelor)

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Why Choose Flinders Aligned?

Flinders Aligned gives students greater confidence when planning their future by recognising both academic achievement and vocational learning. Rather than relying on a single pathway, students have multiple opportunities to progress into selected Flinders University degrees.

How Flinders Aligned works

Flinders Aligned connects three key stages of learning:

- SACE Stage 2 subjects
- Vocational Education and Training (VET)
- Aligned university degrees at Flinders

Students also have the opportunity to incorporate university level study through Extension Studies as part of their aligned pathway.

Through careful alignment, students who complete specific combinations of school subjects and/or VET qualifications can be eligible for entry into selected Flinders degrees, subject to meeting any additional course specific entry requirements (e.g. portfolio, audition, etc).

Each pathway:

- Identifies which school subjects and VET qualifications align with particular degrees
- Recognises VET as meaningful preparation, not an alternative or add-on
- Provides transparent entry requirements, so students know where they are heading

Planning Your Pathway

At CBC, students receive personalised guidance throughout Years 9–11 to help them select the subjects and VET options that best align with their future university and career aspirations. Early planning ensures students remain on track to meet pathway requirements while keeping their options open.

The CBC Advantage

CBC offers on-site VET opportunities, including Certificate III in Business and Certificate III in Sport Coaching, allowing students to gain practical industry skills while working towards their Flinders Aligned pathway. These qualifications complement students' academic studies and strengthen their university preparation.

Important to Know

Students must complete the South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE) and satisfy any course-specific entry requirements, such as prerequisite subjects, portfolios, auditions or interviews where applicable. Individual pathway schedules outline the specific requirements for each eligible degree.

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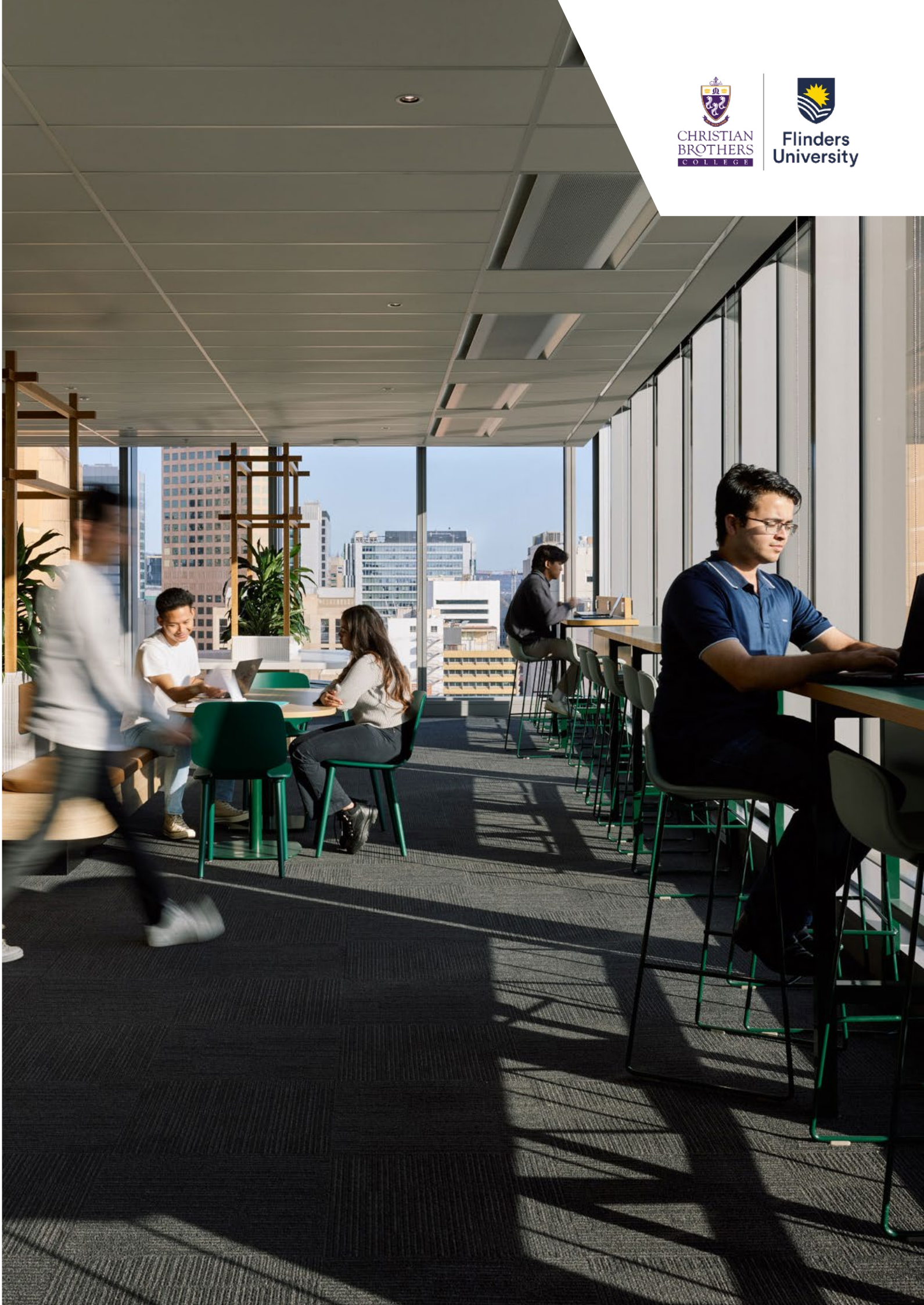
